

Entrepreneurs Fund Terms & Conditions

1. The Entrepreneurs Fund Initiative (“EFI”) is a promotion to grant an award of £20,000 to a successful candidate. The EFI is operated by Reed Global Limited (“Reed”) which is part of the Reed Group of companies. The objective is to help a young person grow their own small business.
2. The EFI is open to residents of the UK aged 18-26 who have a UK business which has been trading for less than 3 years. Applicants must have the right to work in the UK and the type of business and expenditure must be eligible for a grant under the scheme guidelines. Please see reed.com/entrepreneurs for guidance (“Guidance”) on the types of businesses the grant can support.
3. Applicants are allowed a single entry into the EFI and must submit the application form between 7 May 2026 and 7 July 2026. All entries received after 7 July 2026 will be disqualified. Reed accepts no responsibility whatsoever for any technical failure or malfunction or any other problem with any system, server, provider, or otherwise, that may result in any entry being lost, delayed, or not properly registered.
4. To enter, applicants must submit a completed entry form which can be found at reed.com/entrepreneurs.
5. The successful applicants will be selected to receive a grant of £10,000 subject to due diligence checks.
6. The grant is intended to finance the initial costs of scaling a small business, further details are referred to in the Guidance.
7. By submitting an application, the applicant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions. Reed reserves the right to change these terms and conditions at any time.
